North Course Renovation Project

We are very excited to begin the North Course Renovation Project under the close direction of the Tom Fazio Design team. The Fazio Design team, Colony 9 (owners of Forest Creek Golf Club) and the Forest Creek executive staff have worked diligently on the master plan for this project. The scope of work will consist of the following:

Putting Green Conversion

Converting to Champion Bermuda grass, which is a premium ultra-dwarf Bermuda grass for the Pinehurst climate

Bunkers/Waste Areas

Recontouring edges, adding adequate drainage and adding proper level of native sand

Short Game Area

Re-design chipping area to include; larger green with Champion Bermuda grass, relocation of bunkers and additional hitting area for mid-range wedge shots

Turf Conditions

Adding base-line drainage and catch basins throughout the course, as well as double aerifying fairways and tees

Cart Paths

Replace with the more natural sand-like surface or asphalt where needed

Hole #1

A 1/2" layer is being removed from all putting green surfaces, but the surrounds and approaches will have up to six inches removed. This process, along with the upcoming fumigation, will ensure the new putting surface is clear of any contamination. The approaches will be sand capped and receive new sod, which will allow golf shots to more easily release onto the green.



Hole #18

Greenside bunker surrounds will be recontoured and re-sodded. Once the putting surfaces are complete, the bunkers will receive new drainage and sand.

A small waste area left of the fairway is being removed. Similar areas that are typically out of play and require extensive maintenance after a rain event, will be reduced in size or eliminated.
