

Holes #1 and #2

The McDonald & Sons crew, which is based out of Baltimore, MD, have nine greens shaped to finish grade! The next step is to cover the area with a tarp and fumigate. The fumigation is a vital process in eradicating all unwanted rhizomes in the soil.



Prior to grading and shaping each green the rock layer in the subgrade is thoroughly checked for consistency. The crew is repairing an area of the rock layer on the back of #9 green.



Tees and fairways are being heavily aerified this week. This process along with the addition of proper drainage, will greatly help dry out the playing areas after a rain event.



The aerification cores are picked up by this large vacuum and hauled to the dump site.
